

## Apprenticeship & Jobs Orientation Session- Bridge to Livelihoods Project

A Brief orientation session about Apprenticeship & Jobs was conducted at School of Open Learning, University of Delhi on 27<sup>th</sup> Feb'2019 from 1 p.m. onwards by a three-member team from Development Alternatives. The session was supported by Mr. Anurag Mittal, In charge Entrepreneurship Facilitation Center, School of Open Learning, University of Delhi. Around 38 students were present in the session including 14 girls. A needs assessment exercise was done by facilitator Vishakha Mittal, which constituted questions regarding the interest areas of students, sectors they want to work in and the kind of jobs they aspire for.

Concept of apprenticeship was introduced while informing them about the routes, approach and other details about working as an apprentice. The session was highly interactive. Students asked their doubts apprenticeship, how can they manage time while studying and the kind of jobs which are available for graduates/undergraduates right now. There were some students pursuing their Master's degree from SoL. Moreover, apprenticeship leaflets were distributed and candidate detail form was given to them. On the basis of needs assessment, around 10-12 students were ready to join jobs/apprenticeship immediately.
